### Burghs of Dornock, Tain, Dingwall, Wick, and Kirkwall.

James M'Donald, of Langdale, Elq; in the County of Sutherland, in the Room of the Right Honorable John Charles Villiers, who, fince his Election for the faid Clafs or Diftrict of Burghs, hath accepted the Office of Steward or Bailiff of His Majefty's Three Chiltern Hundreds of Stoke, Delborough, and Bonenham, in the County of Buckingham.

Whitehall, July 6, 1805. As feveral Artificers and Manufacturers, Subjects of Great Britain, have, from Time to Time, gone into Foreign Countries to exercise their feveral Callings, contrary to the Laws of these Kingdoms, the following Abstracts of Acts of Parliament of Their late. Majesties King George the First and Second, and of His present Majesty, for preventing such Practices, are published, for the Information of all Persons who may be ignorant of the Penalties they may incur by Difobedience to them : And it will be observed, that fuch Penalties likewife extend to those who are any ways concerned or instrumental in the Sending or Enticing Artificers or Manufacturers out of thefe Kingdoms, or in the Exportation of the Tools and Influments used by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufacturers themselves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27. IF any Perfon shall contract with, entice, or folicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brafs, or worker Metal, Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other Artificer of Great Britain, to go into Foreign Countries out of the King's Dominions, and shall be convicted thereof, upon Indictment or Informa-tion in any of the Courts at Westminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter Seffions, he shall be fined any Sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for the first Offence, and shall be imprifoned. Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Perfon having been once convicted shall offend again, he shall be fined at the Discretion of the Court, and imprifoned Twelve Months, and till the Fine be paid.

If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Arti-ficers, shall go into any Country out of His Ma-jefty's Dominions, to exercise or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any fuch Foreign Country, exercising any of the faid Trades, shall not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minister, or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artificers shall be, or by any Perfon authorifed by fuch Amballador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from henceforth inhabit within this Realm ; fuch Perfons shall be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor or Administrator, or of taking any Lands, &c. within this Kingdom, by Delcent, Devife, or Purchafe, and shall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majefty's |

Enfign George Morfe to be Lieutenant. Dated | Ufe, and shall be deemed Alien, and out of His Majesty's Protection.

Upon Complaint made, upon Oath, before any Juffice of Peace, that any Person is endeavouring to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted or is preparing to go out of His Majefty's Dominions, for the Purposes aforefaid, fuch Juffice may fend his Warrant to bring the Person complained of before him, or before fome other Justice; and if it shall appear by the Oath of One Witnels, or by Confession, that he was guiltyof any of the faid Offences, fuch Justice may bind him to appear at the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions : And if fuch Perfon shall refuse to give Security, the Justice may commit him to Gaol till the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions, and until he shall be delivered by due Courfe of Law. And if any fuch Artificer shall be convicted, upon Indictment, of any fuch Promife, Contract, or Preparation to go beyond the Seas, for the Purpole aforelaid, he shall give fuch Sccurity to the King not to depart out of His Majefty's Dominions, as fuch Court shall think reasonable, and shall be imprisoned till Security given.

If any of the above Offences shall be committed in Scotland, the fame shall be profecuted in the Court of Justiciary or the Circuits there.

## Statute 23 George II. Chap. 13.

IF any Person shall contract with, or endeavour to feduce any Artificer in Wool, Mohair, Cotton, or Silk, or in Iron, Steel, Brass, or other Metal, or any Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or metal, or any Clock-marce, water marce, of any other Artificer in any other of the Manufac-tures of Great Britain or Ireland, to go out of this Kingdom or Ireland into any Foreign Country not within the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, and shall be convicted, upon In-dictment or Information, in the Kings Bench at Westminster, or by Indication, in the Ange Echet at Westminster, or by Indication at the Affizes or General Gaol Delivery for the County, &c. wherein fuch Offence shall be committed in England, or by Indictment in the Court of Jufficiary or any of the Circuit Courts in Scotland, or by Indictment or Information in the. King's Bench at Dublin, if fuch Offence be committed in Irehand; the Person so convicted shall, for every Ar-tificer contracted with or seduced, forfeit FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS, and shall fuffer Imprifonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Forfeiture be paid; And in cafe of a lublequent Offence of the fame Kind, the Perlons to again offending shall forfeit, for every Perlon contracted with or feduced, ONE THOUSAND POUNDS, and shall inffer Imprilonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted, for Two Years, and until fuch Forfeiture be paid.

If any Person in Great Britain or Ireland shall put on board any Ship or Boar, not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, any fuch Tools or Utenfils as are commonly ufed in, or proper for the Preparing, Working up, or Finishing of the Woollen or Silk Manufactures, or any Part of such Tools, he shall, for every Offence, forfeit all fuch Tools, or Parts thereof, put
