that the following Warehoules belonging to the Weft dia Dock Company are fo far completed, that, in India Dock Company, were fo far completed, that, in their Judgment, the fame were fit and proper in every Refpect for the Reception of fuch Goods, Wares, and Merchandize as are enumerated and defcribed in the faid Table annexed to the faid Act of Parliament, marked (A), and wherein the fame might refpectively be fafely and fecurely deposited, and remain under the Regulations and Directions of the faid Act, viz. And whereas by another Certificate under the Hands of Three of the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treasury, bearing Date the Twenty-fixth Day of March laft, the faid Lords Commissioners, purfuant to and in Execution of the Powers vefted in them in and by the faid Act, did thereby declare that it appears to them to be expedient, that the Provifions of the faid Act flould be extended to Wines imported in Ships arriving from the Weft Indies (excepted in Table (B) annexed to the faid Act); and that all Wines imported in Ships arriving from the West Indies, whether the same should have heen shipped on board such Vessels in the West Indies, or elfewhere, might respectively be fafely and fecurely deposited in all or any of the Thirteen Stacks of Warehouses hereinbefore described, and remain therein, under the Regulations and Directions of the faid Act : And the faid Lords Commiffioners did further declare, that from and after the Publication of their Certificate in the London Gazette, conformable to the Directions of the faid Act, all and every the Provisions, Regulations, and Reftrictions of the faid Act. should extend, and be conftrued to extend to all fuch Mone extends and become Ships arriving from the Welt Indies, in every Re-spect in as full and ample a Manner as if the fame had been inferted and enumerated in Table (A) annexed to the faid Act at the Time of paffing the fame :

We the underfigned Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury, do, in pursuance of the faid Act of Parliament, further certify and make known, that the following Warehouses belonging to the West In-

our Judgment, the fame are also fit and proper, in every Respect, for the Reception of fuch Goods, Wares, and Merchandize as are enumerated and described in the faid Table annexed to the faid A& of Parliament, marked (A,) and also for the Reception of Wines imported in Ships arriving from the West Indies, whether the fame shall have been shipped on board fuch Veffels in the Weft Indies or ellewhere, in like Manner as if the fame had been inferted and enumerated in the faid Table (A), as expressed in the faid last mentioned Certificate; and in which Warehouses such Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, including Wines as aforefaid, may refpectively be fafely and fecurely deposited, and remain under the Regulations and Directions of the faid AC; (viz.) All those Two feveral Stacks of Warehouses fituate on the South Side of the Large Dock, belonging to the West India Dock Company, at the Isle of Dogs; and we do hereby declare our Approbation of the faid Two last-mentioned Stacks of Warehouses accordingly.
