Berlin, Jan. 29. Our Elector has appointed the 10th of February for the exposing to Sale the Goods taken on board the Spanish Ship. The Elector of *Saxony* is expected here very suddenly. Our Polish Letters inform us, that the great Affair concerning a War with the Turks had been brought before the Dyet; that it was very eagerly promoted by many, who believe that the Crown of *Poland* has a great deal of reason to be jealous of the great preparations which the Grand Signior is making, and that they therefore ought to provide for their own security, by making a firm Alliance with the Czar of *Moscovy*, and by joyning their Forces with his for their common preservation. The Ambassador that is said to be coming from *Moscovy*, was not arrived at *Warsaw* when our Letters came from thence, and its probable the Dyet will not come to a Resolution in so important a Matter, till they hear what he comes to propose from the Czar, who its said, will have a vast Army in the Field the next Summer, such as will equal, if not exceed that of the Turks.

Brussels, Feb. 14. The Reforme is not yet Declared; but we are assured it will be in a day or two. The States of this Province have resolved to grant the same Subsidies to his Highness, which they gave the last year to the Duke de *Vilva Hermosa*. The Marquis de *Bourgomanero* is now on his departure for *Vienna*, where he is to reside with the Character of Ambassador Extraordinary from the King of *Spain*.

Hague, Feb. 14. Last Wednesday the States of *Holland* met for the first time since their last Recess, and have been busied about finding a Fond to defray the extraordinary charges of the present year, as well as to pay off some old Arrears.
