She proved to be Le Pandour of Eighteen Guns, Six-Pounders, (Two of which were thrown overboard during the Chace.) and One Hundred and Fourteen Men. commanded by M. Malingre, Capitaine de Vaisseau, from Senegal bound to France.

Rear-Admiral Stirling has ordered me to take Possession of her. I have brought her into this Anchorage, and have the Honor to be, &c.
