Tours, and flood towards the Diadem ; and, by this Time, I was fatisfied, from the judicious Manœuvres of the Ships in the Offing, that they could be no other than the Raifonable and Narciffus.

At Twelve the French Frigate paffed within hail of the Diadem, when we changed our Colours from Dutch to English, and directed her to strike, which fhe very properly did immediately, and I fent the Honorable Captain Percy, who was ferving with me as a Volunteer, to take Poffeffion of her. She proved to be La Volontaire ; is nearly Eleven Hundred Tons, and mounts Forty-fix Guns, with a Complement of Three Hundred and Sixty Men on board.

I congratulate their Lordships that, by this Capture, Detachments of the Queen's and 54th Regiments, confifting of Two Hundred and Seventeen Men, who were taken in Two Transports in the Bay -of Bifcay, are reftored to His Majefty's Service.
