A PROCLAMATION,

For granting the Distribution of Prizes during the present Hostilities.

GEORGE R.

MHEREAS by Our Order in Council, dated the Fourteenth of May in the present Year One thousand eight hundred and fix, We have ordered that General Reprifals be granted against the Ships, Goods, and Subjects of the King of Pruffia, and of the Town of Papenburgh, (fave and except any Ships to which Our Licence has been granted, or which have been directed to be released from the late Embargo,) so that as well Our Fleets and Ships, as also all other Ships and Vessels that shall be commissioned by Letters of Marque or General Reprifals or otherwise, by Our Commissioners for executing Our Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, shall and may lawfully seize all Ships, Veffels, and Goods belonging to the King of Prussia, or the Town of Papenburgh, or any Perfons being Subjects of, or belonging to, or inhabiting within the Territories of the King of Prussia, or the Town of Papenburgh, (except as aforefaid,) and bring the same to Judgment in any of Our Courts of Admiralty within Our Dominions, duly authorifed and required to take Cognizance thereof: We being defirous to give due Encouragement to all Our faithful Subjects who shall lawfully seize the fame, and having declared in Council, Our Intentions concerning the Distribution of all Manner of · Captures, Seizures, Prizes, and Reprifals of all Ships and Goods during these Hostilities, do now make known to all Our loving Subjects, and all others whom it may concern, by this Our Proclamation, by and with the Advice and Confent of Qur Privy Council, that Our Will and Pleafure is, that the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken, the Right whereof is inherent in Us and Our Crown, be given; rto the Taker, (fave and except the Produce of such | Eight equal Parts,

Prizes as are, or shall be taken by Ships or Vessels belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commissioners of Customs or Excise, the Disposition of which We reserve to Our further Pleasure; and also save and except as hereinaster mentioned,) but subject to the Payment of all such or the like Customs and Duties as the same are now, or would have been liable to, if the same were, or might have been imported as Merchandize; and that the same may be so given in the Proportion and Manner hereinaster set forth, that is to say,

That all Prizes taken by Ships and Vessels having Commissions of Letters of Marque and Reprisals, (save and except such Prizes as are, or shall be taken by the Ships or Vessels' belonging to, or hired by, or in the Service of Our Commissioners aforesaid,) may be fold and disposed of by the Merchants, Owners, Fitters, and others, to whom such Letters of Marque and Reprisals are granted for their own Use and Benefit, after sinal Adjudication, and not before.

And We do hereby further order and direct, that the Neat Produce of all Prizes which are, or shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Vessels of War, (fave and except when they shall be acting on any conjunct Expedition with Our Army, in which cafe We referve to Ourselves the Division and Distribution of all Prize and Booty taken; and also save and except as hereinafter mentioned,) shall be for the entire Benefit and Encouragement of Our Flag Officers, Captains, Commanders, and other Commissioned Officers in Our Pay, and of the Seamen, Marines, and Soldiers on board Our faid Ships and Vessels at the Time of the Capture, and that such Prizes may be lawfully fold and disposed of by them and their Agents; after the same shall have been to Us finally adjudged lawful Prize, and not other-

The Distribution shall be made as follows: The Whole of the Neat Produce being first divided into Eight equal Parts,
