- The Captain or Captains of any of Our faid Ships ! or Veffels of War, who shall be actually on board at the taking of any Prize, shall have Three Eighth Parts; but in cafe any fuch Prize shall be taken by any of Our Ships or Vessels of War, under the Command of a Flag or Flags, the Flag-Officer or Officers being actually on board, or directing and affilting in the Capture, fhall have one of the Three Eighth Parts; the faid One Eighth Part to be paid to fuch Flag or Flag Officers in fuch Proportions, and fubject to fuch Regulations, as are hereinafter-mentioned.
- The Captains of Marines and Land Forces, Sea Lieutenants, and Master, on board, shall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them; -but that every Phylician appointed, or hereafter to be appointed, to a Fleet or Squadron of Our Ships of War, shall, in the Distribution of Prizes which shall hereafter be taken by the Ships in which he shall ferve, or in which fuch Ship's Company shall be entitled to share, be classed with the Sea Lieutenants with respect to the faid One Eighth Part, and be allowed to thare equally with them; provided such Physician be actually on board at the Time of taking fuch Prizes.
- The Lieutenants and Quarter Maflers of Marines, and Lieutenants, Enligns, and Quarter-Masters of Land Forces, Secretaries of Admirals or of Commodores, with Captains under them, Second Mafters of Line of Battle Ships, Boatfwains, Gunners, Purfers, Carpenters, Masters'-Mates, Chirurgeons, Pilots, and Chaplains on board, fhall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amonglt them.
- The Midshipmen, Captains' Clerks, Master Sailmakers, Carpenters' Mates, Boatfwains'-Mates, Gunners' Mates, Mafters at Arms, Corporals, Yeomen of the Sheets, Coxfwains, Quarter-Mafters, Quarter-Mafters' Mates, Chirurgeons'-Mates, Ycomen of the Powder Room, Serjeants of Matines and Land Forces, on board, shall have One Eighth Part, to be equally divided amongft them.
- The Trumpeters, Quarter- Gunners, Carpenter's Crew, Stewards, Cook, Armourers, Stewards'-Mates, Cooks'-Mates, Gunsmiths, Coopers, Swabbers, Ordinary Trumpeters, Barbers, Able Seamen, Ordinary Seamen, and Marines, and other Soldiers, and all other Perfons doing Duty, and affilting on board, shall have Two Eighth Parts, to be equally divided amongst them.

And We do hereby further order, that, in the Cafe of Cutters, Schooners, Brigs, and other Armed Veffels, commanded by Lieutenants, the Share of fuch Lieutenant shall be Three Eighth Parts of the Prize, unlefs fuch Lieutenants shall be under the Command of a Flag-Officer or Officers, in which Cafe the Flag Officer or Officers shall have One of

the faid Three Eighths, to be divided among fuch Flag Officer or Officers, in the fame Manner herein directed in the Cafe of Captains ferving under Flag-Officers. Secondly, We direct that the Share of the Sub Lieutenant, Mafter, and Pilot, shall be One Eighth; the faid Eighth, if there be all Three fuch Perfons on board, to be divided into Four Parts; Two Parts to be taken by the Sub-Lieutenant, One-Part by the Mafter, and One Part by the Pilot ;if there be only Two fuch Perfons on board, then the Eighth to be divided into Three Parts, of which Two Thirds shall go to the Person Second in Command, and One Third to the other Perfon;-if there be only a Sub-Lieutenant, or a Mafter, and no Pilot, then the Sub Lieutenant or Mafter to take the whole Eighth .- That the Share of the Chirurgeon, or Chirurgeon's-Mate (where there is no Chirurgeon), Midshipmen, Clerk, and Steward, shall be One Eighth .- That the Share of the Boatfwairs, Gunners, and Carpenters'-Mates, Yeomen of the Sheets, Sailmaker, Quarter-Maller, and Quarter. Mafter's Mate, fhall, be One Eighth .- Aud the Share of the Seamen, Marines, and other Perfons on board, affitting in the Capture, shall be Two Eighth Parts.

But it, is Our Intention neverthelefs, that the above Diffribution shall only extend to fuch Cap. tures as shall be made by any Cutter, Schooner, Brig, or Armed Veffel without any of Our Ships or Veffels of War being prefent, or within Sight of, and adding to the Encouragement of the Captors, and Terror of the Enemy; but in cafe any of Our Ships or Veffels of War shall be prefent, or in Sight, that then the Officers, Pilots, Petty Officers, and Men on board fuch Cutters, Schooners, Brigs, or Armed Veffels shall share in the same Proportion. as is allowed to Perfons of the like Rank and Denomination on board of Our Ships and Veffels of War; the Sub-Lieutenant and Malter to be confidered as Warrant Officers; and fuch Cutters, Schooners, Brigs, or Armed Veffels shall not, in respect to fuch Captures, convey any Intereft or Share in the Flag Eighth to the Flag-Officer or Officers under whole Orders fuch Cutters, Schooners, Brigs, and Armed Veffels may happen to be.

And whereas it is judged expedient, during the ; prefent Hoftilities, to hire into Our Service Armed. Veffels, to be employed as Cruizers againft the Enemy; which Veffels are the Property of, and : their Mafters and Ciews are paid by, the Merchants of whom they are hired, although feveral of them. are commanded by Our Commissioned Officers in a Our Pay, it is Our further Will and Pleafure, that, the Neat Produce of all Prizes taken by fuch Hired . Armed Veffels, (except as hereinafter-mentioned,). shall be for the Benefit of Gur Commissioned Officers) in Our Pay, and of the Mafters and Crews on board ; the faid Hired Armed Veffels at the Time of the, Capture ; and that fuch Prizes may be lawfully fuld ;
