Perfons in Our Pay.—Three Eighths shall belong to and be divided among the other Officers, and the rest of the Crew.—And in the Case of Prizes taken by any Hired Armed Veffel not commanded by any of Our Commissioned Officers, One Eighth shall belong to the Flag-Officers, to be divided as aforefaid, in case such Hired Armed Vessel shall be under the Command of a Flag .- Two Eighths shall belong to the Master and Mate, of which the Master shall take Two Thirds, and the Mate One Third.—Three Eighths shall belong to and be divided among the other Officers, and the rest of ţ the Crew, in Manner aforefaid.—The Surplus, the Distribution of which is not herein directed, shall remain at Our Disposal; and if not disposed of . within a Year after final Adjudication, the fame fhall belong and be paid to Greenwich Holpi-tal — And in the Cafe of Prizes taken jointly by any of Our Ships of War, and any Hired Armed Veffel, Our Commissioned Officer or Officers on board fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall share with Our Commissioned Officer or Officers of the fame Rank on board Our Ship or Ships of War, being joint Captors; the Malter of fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall share with the Warrant Officers; the . Mate of fuch Hired Armed Veffel with the Petty Officers; and the Seamen of fuch Hired Armed Veffel with the Seamen on board Our faid Ship or Ships of War; fave and except that, in cafe fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall be commanded by one of Our Commiffioned Officers having the Rank of Mafter and Commander, and there should be none of Our Lieutenants on board ; or in cafe fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall be commanded by the Mafter, in both those Cases the Mafter of fuch Hired Armed Vessel shall share with the Lieutenants of 'Our Ships of War, and the Mate with the Warrant Officers .- And in cafe any Difficulty shall arife in respect to the faid Diffribution, not herein sufficiently provided for, the fame shall be referred to Our Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty, whole Direction thereupon shall be final, and have the same force and effect as if herein inferted.

Provided that if any Officer being on board any of Our Ships of War at the Time of taking any Prize, Thall have more Commiffions or Offices than One, fuch Officer fhall be entitled only to the Share or Shares of the Prizes which, according to the above-mentioned Diftribution, fhall belong to his fuperior Commiffion or Office.

Provided alfo, that in all Prizes taken by any of Our Squadrons, Ships, or Veffels while acting in Conjunction with any Squadron, Ship, or Veffel of any other Power that may be in Alliance with Us, a Share of fuch Prizes shall be fet apart, and be at Our further Difposal equal to that Share which the Flag, and other Officers and Crews of fuch Squadron, Ships, or Veffels would have been entitled to if they had belonged to Us.

And We do hereby firiftly enjoin all Commanders of Our Ships and Veffels of War taking any Prize, to transmit, as foon as may be, or caufe to be transmitted to the Commissioners of Our Navy, a true Lift of the Names of all the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, and others who were actually on board Our Ships and Veffels of War under their Command at the Time of the Capture; which Lift

shall contain the Quality of the Service of each Person on board, together with the Description of the Men, taken from the Defcription Books of the capturing Ship or Ships and their feveral Ratings, and be fubfcribed by the Captain or Commanding Officer, and Three or more of the Chief Officers on board : And We do hereby require and direct the Commiffioners of Our Navy, or any Three or more of them, to examine, or caufe to be examined fuch Lifts, by the Mufter Books of fuch Ships and Veffels of War and Lifts annexed thereto, to fee that fuch Lifts do agree with the faid Mufter Books and annexed Lifts, as to the Names, Qualities, or Ratings of the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Suldiers and others belonging to fuch Ships and Veffels of War; and upon Requelt, forthwith to grant a Certificate of the Truth of any Lift transmitted to them, to the Agents nominated and appointed by the Captors to take Care and difpole of fuch Prize; and also upon Application to them (the faid Commiffioners,) they shall give, or cause to be given to the faid Agents, all fuch Lifts from the Multer Books of any fuch Ships of War and annexed Lifts, as the faid Agents shall find requisite for their Direction in paying the Produce of fuch Prizes; and otherwife shall be aiding and affisting to the faid Agents in all fuch Matters as shall be necessary.

We do hereby further will and direct that the fol. lowing Regulations shall be observed concerning the One Eighth Part hereinbefore mentioned, to be granted to the Flag or Flag-Officers who shall actual-ly be on board at the taking of any Prize, or shall be directing or affiling therein. First, That a Captain of a Ship shall be deemed to be under the Com-mand of a Flag when he shall actually have received fome Order directly from, cr be acting in Execution of fome Order iffued by a Flag Officer, and fhall be deemed to continue under the Command of fuch Flag, fo long as the Flag Officer, by whom the Order was islued, or any other Flag-Officer acting upon the fame Station, shall continue upon fuch Station, or until fuch Captain shall have received fome Order directly from, or be acting in Execution of fome Order islued by fome other Flag-Officer, or the Lords Commissioners of the Admiralty. Secondly, That a Flag Officer Commander in Chief, when there is but one Flag-Officer upon Service, shall have to his own Ule the faid One Eighth Part of the Prizes taken by Ships and Veffels under his Command. Thirdly, That a Flag-Officer fent to command on any Station, shall have no Right to any Share of Prizes taken by Ships or Veffels employed there, before he arrives within the Limits of fuch Station, and actually takes upon him the Command by communicating Orders to the Flag-Officer previoully in Command, fave only that he fhall be entitled to a Share of Prizes taken by those particular Ships to which he fhall actually have given fome Order, and taken under his Command within the Limits of fuch Station. Fourthly, That a Commander in Chief, or other Flag-Officer appointed or belorging to any Station, and paffing through or into any other Station, shall not be entitled to fhare in any Prize taken out of the Limits of the Station to which he is appointed or belongs, by any Ship or Veffel under the Command of a Flag-Officer of any other Station, or under Admi-
