Whitehall, June 27, 1806.

Whereas it has been humbly represented to His Majesty, that on the Night of the 18th of April last, a Boat belonging to the *Mermaid Cutter*, in the Service of His Majesty's Customs in attempting to bring to a Smuggling Luggur off *Dunfenborough Castle*, was fired upon by a Volley of small Arms from the said Luggur, and beaten off, and the said Luggur effected her Escape in the Haze, which Luggur is supposed to belong either to one *Taplow*, who sometimes resides at *Redcar*, and sometimes at *Boomer*, or to one *Dangerfield*;

His Majesty, for the better discovering and bringing to Justice the Persons concerned in the said Felony is hereby pleased to promise His most gracious Pardon to any one or more of the said Offenders (except the Master of the said Smuggling Luggur,) who shall discover his Accomplices therein, so that any one or more of them may be apprehended and convicted of the said Offence.

Whitehall, June 30, 1806.

Whereas it hath been humbly represented to the King, that on Tuesday Evening the 24th Instant, about Five o'Clock, the Reverend *George Parker*, Rector of *Oddingley*, in the County of *Worcester*, was most cruelly murdered in a Field, within the Parish of *Oddingley*, and within a short Distance of his own Dwelling-House, by receiving a Shot from a Gun, which entered the Right Side of his Body near the short Ribs, his Skull fractured, and his Head otherwise very much beaten with the Butt-end of such Gun; And whereas it hath been further represented to the King, that *Richard*
