An Act for altering and enlarging the Provisions of an Act passed in the Parliament of Ireland, in the Thirty-third Year of His present Majesty, for making and constituting a new Parish, by the Name of the Parish of Saint George, on the Ground adjoining the City of Dublin, therein described, and for erecting and building a Parish Church therein.

An Act to continue and amend Two Acts passed in the Third and Fifteenth Years of His present Majesty, for repairing the Road from Newmarket, over Newmarket-Heath, to the Turnpike Road leading to Stump-Cross, in the Counties of Cambridge and Suffolk, and other Roads mentioned in the said Acts.

An Act for more effectually improving the Roads leading to and from the Port, Harbour, and Town of Whitehaven, in the County of Cumberland.
