"Had General Regnicr thought proper to re-main upon his Ground, the Difficulties of Accels to him were fuch that I could not possibly have made an Impression upon him. But quitting this Advantage, and croffing the River with his entire Force, he came down to meet us upon the open Plain-a Measure to which he was no doubt encouraged by a Confideration of his Cavalry, an Arm with which, unfortunately, I was altogether unprovided."
