PRESENT,

The KING's Moft Excellent Majefty in Council. 7 HEREAS it hath been reprefented to His Majefty, that, over and above the Royal Duties, and the Confulate or Municipal Duties, payable upon divers Articles exported from the City, Town, and Fortrefs of Buenos Ayres, and its Dependencies, including therein all and every the Territories belonging to, or forming a Part of, the Government of the fame, a Duty of Two Reals upon each Ox Hide, and of One Real upon each Horfe Hide, exported, was levied and paid during the Time the faid City, Town, and Fortrefs of Buenos Ayres, and its Dependencies, were under the Spanish Govern. ment : And whereas the Commander of His Majefty's Forces, to whom the faid City, Town, and Fortrefs have furrendered, has thought fit, until His Majefty's Pleafure should be known, to reduce the faid additional Duty to One Real upon each Ox Hide, and to make a proportionate Reduction of the Duty payable upon each Horfe Hide exported ;-His Majefty is thereupon pleafed to order and declare, that the faid Reduced Duties, and no other, shall, until the further Signification of His Majefty's Pleafure, continue to be paid upon each Ox Hide and Horfe Hide exported as aforefaid, in British Ships, owned by His Majefty's Subjects, and navigated according to Law; or in Ships bonâ fide belonging to any of the Subjects or Native Inhabi tants of the faid City, Town, and Territories, fuch Native Inhabitants being peaceably refident within the fame, and under the Obedience of His Majesty's Government there :- And the Right Honorable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treasury, and the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may respectively appertain. The KING's Molt Excellent Majefty in Council. T is this Day ordered by His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, that Horfes, Mules, Affes, Neat Cattle, Sheep, Hogs. Poultry, and every other Species of Live Stock and Live Provisions, be added to the Articles which His Majesty, by His Order in Council of the Seventeenth of last Month, has authorized the Governors and Lieutenant-Governors of His Majefty's Islands and Colonies in the Weft Indies, (in which Defcription the Bahama Islands, and the Bermuda or Somer's Islands, are included,) and of any Lands or : Territories on the Continent of South America to His Majefty belonging, to permit to be imported into the faid Islands, Colonics, Lands, and Territories respectively; and that the faid additional Ar. ticles be accordingly permitted to be fo imported, in . the Manner, for the Time, and under the Terms and Conditions mentioned in the faid Order.
