The Commissioners think it necessary to publish the following Extract from the 19th Article of the Deed of Agreement:

“ Provided always, That no Claim, except as herein is excepted, shall be absolutely established until the Expiration of Two Years from the Time when it shall be first taken into Consideration by the said Commissioners in England, unless it shall first have been thoroughly investigated and reported upon by the Commissioners in India; during which Period of Two Years the said Commissioners in England shall cause strict inquiry to be made in India as to such Claim, and whether it has been satisfied wholly or in part, and they shall be open to receive any Objections and Evidence against such Claim, during the said Period of Two Years.”

With a View, however, to expedite the final Adjudication of the Claims, the Commissioners recommend to the Parties interested to avail themselves of the earliest Opportunity of making their Objections.

The Principals, Executors, Administrators, and Agents named in the foregoing Lists, are requested to report their Place of Residence to the Office of the Commissioners, in order that they may be informed when it is requisite for them to attend; and it will be necessary to produce the original Bonds or Vouchers, if such be in their Possession, and the original Probates of Wills, Letters of Administration, and Powers of Attorney, under which they act and have signed the Deed.
