BY THE LORDS COMMISSIONERS OF HIS MAJESTY'S TREASURY.

HEREAS by an Act, paffed in the Forty-third Year of His prefent Majefty's Reign, intituled, " An Act for permitting certain Goods imported " into Great Britain to be fecured in Warehoufes, " without Payment of Duty," it is enacted, That it should be lawful for the Importer or Importers, Proprietor or Proprietors, Confignee or Confignees of any of the Goods, Wares, or Merchandize enumerated or described in the Table thereunto annexed, marked (B), and which shall be legally imported and brought into the Port of London, to lodge and fecure the fame under the Joint Locks of the Crown and the London Dock Company, in any Warehoufe or Warehoufes erected or to be erected, fituate within the Premifes belonging to the London Dock Company, without Payment at the Time of the first Entry of fuch Goods, Wares, and Merchandize of the Duties of Cuftoms or Excife due on the Importation thereof, fubject neverthelefs, to the Rules, Regulations, and Reftrictions therein contained; provided that no fuch Goods, Wares, or Merchandize fhould be fo lodged or fecured unlefs, and until fuch Warehoufes or other Works belonging, or to belong thereto, fhould be fo far completed, that in the Judgment of the Lord High Treasurer, or the Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treasury for the Time being, or any Three or more of them, the fame shall be fit and proper, in every Respect, for the Reception of fuch Goods, Wares, and Merchandize, and wherein the fame might refpectively be fafely and fecurely deposited, and remain under the Regulations and Directions in the faid Act contained; and the faid Lord High Treafurer, or Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury for the Time being, or any Three or more of them, were thereby authorized and empowered, by Writing under his or their Hand or Hands, to certify and make known his or their Approbation of fuch Warehoufes, which Certificate fhould be published Three Times at leaft, in the London Gazette, and in Two or more public Morning Newspapers usually

circulated in London. And whereas the Table marked (B), above referred to, is in the Words following, viz.
