An Act to continue, until the Fifth Day of July One thousand eight hundred and eight, seyeral Acts for granting certain Rates and Duties, and for allowing certain Drawbacks and Bounties on Goods, Wares, and Merchandize imported into, and ex-

ported from Ireland.
