Lat. 56 Deg. 27 Min. and

W. Long 2 Deg. 27 Min. The Mooriaga of this Light confift, of a Mufhroom Anchor, with a Chain, laid down in 17 Fa-thoms Water, the Bell Rock bearing by the Compals, E. S. E. diftant One Mile; the Red Head, N. by E. 4 E. diftant Thirteen Miles; Fifenels, S. W. 4 W. diftant Twelve Miles; and the Illand of May, S. W. 2 S. diftant Seventeen Miles.

The Light will be from Oil, and will be lighted upon the Night of the 15th Day of September 1807, and thereafter every Night, from the going away of Daylight in the Evening till the Return of Daylight in the Morning. Interval of a Minute, Night and Day. Although this Veffel has been fitted out in the completelt Manner, and every Attention paid to smooring her properly, yet as all floating Lights are liable to break adrift in the tempeftuous Weather of Winter, Mariners are recommended not to neglect their Land Marks, and to run with Caution for the floating Light.
