or Non-Commiffioned Officers or Privates, shall | guard, or affift in guarding, any Seizure which fhall have been made by any Officer or Officers of Cuftoms or Excife, and at which Seizure no Commiffioned, or fuch Warrant or Non-Commiffioned Officer as aforefaid, shall be prefent, there shall be paid the Rewards following ; that is to fay,

- For all Spirits of any Kind whatever, calculated and computed at an Average Strength of One in 'Five under Hydrometer Proof, One Shilling the Gallon.
- Tobacco and Snuff, One Penny Halfpenny the Pound.
- And for Wine, Tea, Salt, and other Articles, Ten per Cent. upon the Appraifed Value thereof.

And His Majefty is further pleafed, by and with the Advice aforefaid, to order and direct, and doth hereby order and direct, that in all Cafes where any Soldiers shall aid and affift any Officer or Officers of Cuftoms or Excife, where no Commiffioned, or any · fuch Warrant or Non-Commissioned Officer as aforefaid, shall be prefent in detaining, or affisting in detaining, any Perlon or Perfons liable to be arrefted -or detained under the Provisions of either of the faid Acts, there shall be paid a Sum equal to One Half of the Amount of the Sum which shall be awarded by the Commiffioners of Cuftoms or Excife refpectively, for the arrefling and Detention of any fuch Man or Men.

And His Majefty is further pleased, by and with the Advice aforefaid, to order and direct, and doth hereby order and direct, that fuch Sums shall be paid with all poffible Difpatch, and without waiting for the Condemnation of fuch Goods; and whether fuch Goods shall be condemned or not by the Commiffioners of His Majefty's Cuftoms and Excife refpectively, to the Agent or Agents of the Regigiment, Battalion, or Corps to which the Soldiers to aiding and affifting, or the Commiffioned, or Warrant, or Non-Commiffioned Officers or Privates fo guarding, fhall belong; and the Commiffioners of the Cuftoms and Excife refpectively are hereby required, once in every Three Months, to transmit to the Secretary at War an Account of all fuch Sums of Money, and to whom the fame shall have been respectively paid.

And His Majefty, in purfuance of the faid laftmentioned Act of Parliament, is also gracioufly pleafed to order and direct, and doth hereby order and direct, that the Rewards given by any Act of Parliament relating to the Revenues of Cultoms or Excife in Cafes of Seizures; and all Sums of Money arifing out of any Shares of Seizures made by any Commiffioned, or by any fuch Warrant or Non-Commissioned Officers as aforefaid, and also the Rewards hereinbefore fpecified for aiding, affifting, or guarding as aforefaid, shall be divided and distributed amongst the Commissioned, and Warrant, and

prefent at the Seizure, or perfonally aiding and affifting, or guarding, and the Commiffioned, and Warrant, and Non-Commissioned Officers and Privates of the Regiment, Battalion, or Corps to which they shall belong, in the following Proportions; that is to fay, To the Commiffioned, and Warrant, and Non Commiffioned Officers and Privates actually prefent at any Seizure, or perfonally aiding and affifting, or guarding as aforefaid, as an Encouragement for their Exertion and Activity, the following Shares :
