Notice is hereby given, that Application is intended to be made to Parliament in the next Session for an Act to enable "The Company of Proprietors of the Navigation from the Trent to the Mersey" to vary the Line of their Canal at or through Harecastle Hill, in the County of Stafford, and which will pass through the Townships or Liberties of Tunstall, Ranscliffe, and Talk o'th' Hill, in the Parishes of Wollstanton and Audley, in the said County; and also to alter and amend several Acts passed in the Sixth, Tenth, Fifteenth, Sixteenth, Twenty-third, Thirty-seventh, and Forty-second Years of the Reign of His present Majesty, particularly in respect to the Mode of rating the Property of the Company to the Maintenance of the Poor, and the Passage of Boats through the
