T is this Day ordered by His Majesty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, that no Ships or Veffels belonging to any of His Majefty's Subjects be permitted to enter and clear out for any of the Ports within the Dominions of the Emperor of Ruffia until further Order; and His Majefty is further pleafed to order, that a general Embargo, or Stop, be made of all Ships and Veffels whatfoever belonging to the Subjects of the Emperor of Ruffia now within, or which thall hereafter come into, any of the Ports, Harbours, or Roads within any Part of His Majefty's Dominions, together with all Perfons and Effects on board all fuch Ships and Veffels; and that the Commanders of His Majefty's Ships of War and Privateers do detain and bring into Port all Ships and Veffels belonging to the Subjects of the Emperor of Ruffia, or bearing the Flag of the Emperor of Ruffia; but that the utmoft Care be taken for the Prefervation of all and every Part of the Cargoes on board any of the faid Ships or Veffels, fo that no Damage or Embezzlement whatever be fultained; and the Commanders of His Majefty's Ships of War and Privateers are hereby instructed to detain and bring into Port every fuch Ship and Veffel accordingly : And the Right Honourable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury, the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may respectively appertain. The KING's Most Excellent Majesty in Council. WHEREAS it has been reprefented that it would be expedient to fix certain Periods at 1

thall have elapfed for receiving Information, at diffe-rent Places, of His Majefty's Order in Council of the Eleventh of November inftant, refpecting the Trade with His Majefty's Enemies, and in their Produce and Manufactures ; His Majefty taking the fame into Confideration, and being defirous to obviate any Difficulties that may arife in refpect thereto, and alfo to allow ample Time for the faid Order being known to all Perfons who may be affected thereby, is pleafed, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, to order and declare, and it is hereby ordered and declared, that Information of the faid Order of the Eleventh of November inftant shall be taken and held to have been received in the Places hereinafter-mentioned, at the Periods refpectively affigned to them; namely,

- Ports and Places within the Baltic-December 21, 1807.
- Other Ports and Places to the Northward of Amfterdam—December 11, 1807. From Amfterdam to Ufhant—December 4, 1807.
- From Ufhant to Cape Finifterre-December 8, 1807.
- From Cape Finisterre to Gibraltar, inclusive-December 13, 1807. Madeira—December 13, 1807.
- Ports and Places within the Streights of Gibraltar, to Sicily and Malta, and the Weft Coaft of Italy, inclusive—January 1, 1808. All other Ports and Places in the Mediterranean
- beyond Sicily and Malta-January 20, 1808.
- Ports and Places beyond the Dardanelles-February 1, 1808.
- Any Part of the North and Western Coast of Africa, or the Iflands adjacent, except Madeira -January 11, 1808.
- The United States, and British Posseffions in North America and the Weft Indies-January 20, 1808.
- Cape of Good Hope, and East Coast of South America-March 1, 1808.

India-May 1, 1808.

China, and the Coaft of South America-June 1, 1808.

And every Veffel failing on or after those Days, from those Places respectively, shall be deemed and taken
