mand of a Flag.-Two-Eighths shall belong to the Master and Mate; of which the Master shall take Two-Thirds, and the Mate One-Third .-Three-Eighths shall belong to and be divided among the other Officers and the rest of the Crew in Manner aforesaid .- The Surplus, the Distribution of which is not herein directed, shall remain at Our Disposal; and if not disposed of within a Year after final Adjudication, the same fhall belong and be paid to Greenwich-Hofpital. —And in the Cafe of Prizes taken jointly, by any of Our Ships of War and any Hired Armed Veffel, Our Commiffioned Officer or Officers on board fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall share with Our Commissioned Officer or Officers of the same Rank on board Our Ship or Ships of War, being joint Captors; the Master of such Hired Armed Veffel shall share with the Warrant Officers; the Mate of fuch Hired Armed Veffel with the Petty Officers; and the Seamen of fuch Hired Armed Veffel with the Seamen on board Our faid Ship or Ships of War; fave and except, that, in cafe fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall be commanded by One of Our Commiffioned Officers having the Rank of Malter and Commander, and there shall be none of Our Lieutenants on board ; or in cafe fuch Hired Armed Veffel shall be commanded by the Master, in both those Cases the Master of such Hired Armed Veffel shall share with the Lieutenants of Our Ships of War, and the Mate with the Warrant Officers.-And in cafe any Difficulty shall arise in respect to the said Dillribution, not herein fufficiently provided for, the same shall be referred to Our Lords Commillioners of the Admiralty, whole Direction thereupon shall be final, and have the fame Force and Effect as if herein inferted : Provided that if any Officer, being on board any of Our Ships of War at the Time of taking any Prize, shall have more Commissions or Offices ahan one, fuch Officer shall be entitled only to the Share or Shares of the Prizes which, according to the abovementioned Diftribution, shall belong to his fuperior Commiffion or Office.—Provided alfo, that in all Peizes taken by any of Our Squadrons, Ships, or Vessels, while acting in Conjunction with any Squadron, Ship, or Veffel of any other Power that may be in Alliance with Us, a Share of fuch Prizes thall be fet apart, and be at Our further Disposal, equal to that Share which the Flag and other Officers and Crews of fuch Squadron, Ships, or Veffels would have been entitled to if they had belonged to Us.

And We do hereby ftrictly enjoin all Commanders of Our Ships and Veffels of War taking any Prize, to tranfmit, as foon as may be, or caufe to be tranfmitted, to the Commiffioners of Our Navy, a true Lift of the Names of all the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, and others, who were actually on board Our Ships and Veffels of War under their Command at the Time of the Capture ; which Lift fhall contain the Quality of the Service of each Perfon on board, together with the Defcription of the Men, taken from the Defcription-Books of the capturing Ship or Ships, and their feveral Ratings, and be fubferibed by the Captain or Commanding Officer, and Three or more of the Chief Officers on board. And We do hereby require and direct the Commiffioners of Our Navy, or any Three or more of them, to examine, or caute to be examined, fuch

Lifts, by the Mufter Books of fuch Ships and Veffels of War, and Lifts annexed thereto, to fee that fuch Lifts do agree with the faid Mufter-Books and annexed Lifle, as to the Names, Qualities, or Ratings of the Officers, Seamen, Marines, Soldiers, and others, belonging to fuch Ships and Veffels of War, and, upon Requeit, forthwith to grant a Certificate of the Truth of any Lift transmitted to them, to the Agents nominated and appointed by the Captors, to take care and dispose of such Prize; and alfo, upon Application to them (the faid Commiffiouers), they shall give, or cause to be given, to the faid Agents, all fuch Lifts from the Mufter-Booke of any fuch Ships of War, and annexed Lifts, as the faid Agents shall find requisite for their Direction in paying the Produce of fuch Prizes; and otherwile shall be aiding and affilting to the faid Agents in all fuch Matters as shall be necessary .--We do hereby further will and direct, that the following Regulations shall be observed concerning the Onc-Eighth Part hereinbefore mentioned, to be granted to the Flag or Flag-Officers who shall actually be on board at the taking of any Prize, or shall be

directing or affishing therein : First, That a Captain of a Ship shall be deemed to be under the Command of a Flag, when he shall actually have received fome Order directly from, or be acting in execution of, fome Order iffued by a Flag-Officer : and shall be deemed to continue under the Command of fuch a Flag, lo long as the Flag-Officer by whom the Order was iffued, or any other Flag-Officer acting upon the fame Station, shall continue upon fuch Station; or until fuch Captain shall have received fome Order directly from, or be acting in execution of, fome Order illued by fome other Flag-Officer, or the Lords Commiffioners of the Admiralty. - Secondly, That a Flag-Officer, Commander in Chief, when there is but One Flag-Officer upon Service, shall have to his own Use the faid One-Eighth Part of the Prizes taken by Ships and Veffels under Iris Command.—Thirdly, That a Flag Officer fent to command on any Station shall have no Right to any Share of Prizes taken by Ships or Vessels employed there, before he arrives within the Limits of fuch Station, and actually takes upon him the Command, by communicating Orders to the Flag-Officer previoufly in Command; fave only that he shall be entitled to a Share of Prizes taken by those particular Ships to which he shall actually have given fome Order, and taken under his Command within the Limits of fuch Station .--Fourthly, That a Commander in Chief, or other Flag-Officer, appointed or belonging to any Station, and paffing through or into any other Station, shall not be entitled to share in any Prize taken out of the Limits of the Station to which he is appointed or belongs, by any Ship or Veffel under the Com-mand of a Flag-Officer of any other Station, or under Admiralty Orders; unlefs fuch Commander in Chief, or Flag-Officer, is expressly authorized by the Lords Commiflioners of the Admiralty to take upon him the Command in that Station in which the Prize is taken, and shall actually have taken upon him fuch Command in Manner aforefaid. -Fifthly, That when an inferior Flag-Officer is fent to reinforce a superior Flag-Officer on any Station, the superior Flag-Officer shall have no Right to any Share of Prizes taken by the inferior Flag-Officer before the inferior Flag-Officer shall
