Ships or Veffels shall duly enter into, report, and deliver their respective Cargoes, and re-load at such Ports only where regular Custom-Houses shall have been eftablished : And His Majetty, by and with the Advice of His faid Privy Council, is further pleafed to order, and doth hereby order, that notwithfianding any Thing hereinhefore contained, the faid Permiffion and Authority to import and export shall ceafe and determine, or be varied and altered, before the Expiration of the abovementioned Period of Twelve Months, at the Expiration of Six Mouths after the Notification in the London Genetice of any Order of His Majefty, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, for revoking, varying, or altering fuch Per-million and Authority, or shall ceale and determine at the Expiration of Six Months after the Ratification of a Definitive Treaty of Peace.

A Letter and its Inclofures, seceived from Vice Admiral Sir Edward Pellow, Bart. Gommander in Chief of His Majefly's Ships and Peffels in the Eafl Indies, addreffed to William Morfden, Efg; dated on board the Culloden, Grieffe Harbour, the 14th December 1807, conveys the following Intelligence :

T appears that the Vice-Admiral had failed from A Malacca on the 20th of November laft, and had arrived with the Squadron of His Majelty's Ships named in the Margin*, of Point Panka, at the Eastern Extremity of Java, on the 5th of the following Month, with the Troops embarked on board them; that, in Conjunction with Lieutenant-Colo-nel Lockhart, commanding the Proops, he had her Lockhart, commanding the Aroops, he had fent a Commission under a Flag of Truce to treat with the Commandant of the Dutch Naval Force, for the Surrender of the Ships of War lying at Grieffe; and by Copies of the Correspondence which paffed in confequence, it appears that the Admiral had caufed the Ships named at the Foot hereof to be burnt (they having been previoufly fcuttled by the Dutch ; that all the Guns, Military Stores &c. in the Garrifon of Grieffe, had, together with the Battery of Sambelangan, on the Island of Madura, been most effectually dettroyed.
