Whitehall, October 14, 1809.

As feweral Artificers and Manufacturers, Subjets of Great Britain, have, from Time to Time, gone into Foreign Countries to Exercise their feweral Callings, opntrary to the Laws of these Kingdoms, the following Abstracts of Acts of Particument of Their late Majesties King George the First and Second, and of His present Majesty, for preventing such Practices, are published, for the Information of all Persons who may be ignorant of the Penalties they may incur by Disobclience to them : And it will be observed, that such Penalties likewise extend to these subso are any ways concerned or instrumental in the Sending or Enticing Artificers or Manufacturers out of these Kingdoms, or in the Exportation of the Tools and Instruments used by them, as well as to the Artificers or Manufacturers themselves.

Statute 5 George I. Chap. 27.

TF any Perfon shall contract with, entice, or solicit, any Artificer in Wool, Iron, Steel, Brais, or other Metal, Clock-maker, Watch-maker, or any other. Artificer of Great. Britain, to go into Foreign Countries out of the King's Dominions, and shall be convicted thereof, upon Indictment or Information in any of the Courts at Westminster, or at the Affizes or Quarter Schlions, he shall be fined any Sum not exceeding ONE HUNDRED POUNDS for the first Offence, and shall be imprisoned Three Months, and till the Fine be paid. And if any Perfon having been once convicted shall offend again, he shall be fined at the Diferetion of the Court, and imprisoned Twelve Months, and till the Fine be paid.

If any of the King's Subjects, being fuch Artificers, thall go into any Country out of His Majefty's Dominions, to exercile or teach the faid Trades to Foreigners; and if any of the King's Subjects in any luch Foreign Country, exercifing any of the faid Trades, thall not return into this Realm within Six Months after Warning given by the Ambaffador, Minifter, or Conful of Great Britain, in the Country where fuch Artificers shall be, or by any Perfon authorifed by fuch Ambaffador, &c. or by one of the Secretaries of State, and from henceforth minabit within this Realm; fuch Perfons that be incapable of taking any Legacy, or of being an Executor or Administrator, or of taking any Lands, &c. within this Kingdom, by Delcent, Devife, or Purchafe, and shall forfeit all Lands, Goods, &c. within this Kingdom, to His Majesty's Ufe, and thall be deemed Alien, and out of His Majesty's Protection.

Upon Complaint made, upon Oath, before asy Juffice of Prace; that any Perion is endeavouring to feduce any fuch Artificer, or that any fuch Artificer hath contracted or is preparing to go out of His Majefty's Dominions, for the Purpofes aforefaid, fuch Juffice may fend his Warrant to bring the Perion complained of before him, or before Some other Juffice; and if it fhall appear by the Oath of One Witnefs; or by Confelion, that he was guilty of any of the faid Offences, fuch Juffice may bind him to appear at the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions: And if fuch Perfon thall refute to give Security, the Juffice may commit him to Gaol till the next Affizes or Quarter Seffions, and until he fhall be delivered by due Courfe of Law. And if any fuch Artificer that be convicted, upon Indictment, sof any fuch Promite, Contract, or Preparation to go

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beyond the Seàs, for the Purpofe aforefaid, he fhall give fuch Sccurity to the King not to depart out of His Majefty's. Dominions, as fuch Court fhall think reafonable, and fhall be imprifoned till Security given. If any of the above Offences fhall be committed

If any of the above Offences shall be committed in Scotland, the same shall be profecuted in the Court of Juliciary or the Circuits there.

Statute 23 George II. Chap. 13.

EF any Perfon thall contract with, or endeavour to feduce any Artificer in Wool, Mohair, Cot-ton, or Silk, or in Iron, Steel, Brafs, or other Metal, or any Clock-maker, Watch maker, or any other Artilicer in any other of the Manufac-tures of Great Britain or Ireland, to go out of this Kingdom or Ireland into any Foreign Country not within the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, and shall be convicted, upon In-dictment or Information, in the King's Bench at Weitminfter, or by Indictment at the Affizes or General Gaol Delivery for the County, &c. wherein fuch Offence shall be committed in England, or by Indictment in the Court of Jufficiary or any of the Circuit Courts in Scotland, or by Indictment or Information in the King's Bench at Dublin, if fuch Offence be committed in Ireland ; the Perfon fo convicted shall, for every Artificer contracted with or feduced, forfeit FIVE HUNDRED POUNDS, and shall suffer Impri-fonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender shall be convicted for Twelve Calendar Months, and until Fortesture be paid: Aud in cale of a sublequent Offence of the fame Kind, the Persons so again offending shall forfeit, for every Person contracted with or seduced, ONE THOUSAND POUNDS, and shall suffer Imprisonment in the Common Gaol of the County or Stewartry wherein fuch Offender (hall be convicted, for Two Years, and antil fuch Forfeiture be paid.

If any Perfon in Great Britain or Ireland thall put on board any Ship or Boat, not bound directly to fome Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain, any fuch Tools or Utenfils as are commonly ufed in, or proper for the Preparing, Working up, or Finithing of the Woollen or Silk Manufactures, or any Part of fuch Tools, he thall, for every Offence, forfeit all fuch Tools, or Parts thereof, put on board, and TWO HUNDRED POUNDS, to be recovered by Action of Debt, &c. in any Court of Record at Weftminfter, or in the Court of Seffion in Scotland, or at any of the Four Courts in Dublin respectively, wherein no Effoin, &c. thall be allowed.

It thall be lawful for any Officer of the Cultoms in Great Britain, or for any Officer of the Revenue in Ireland, to feize and fecure, in fome of His Majefty's Warehoules, all fuch Tools or Utentils prohibited to be exported, as fuch Officer ihall find on board any Veffel not bound directly to fome. Port in Great Britain or Ireland, or to fome other of the Dominions of the Crown of Great Britain; and all Tools fo feized shall, after Condemnation, be publicly fold to the belt Bidder; and one Moiety of the Produce shall be to the Ufe of His Majefty, and the other Moiety to the Officer who shall feize and fecure the fame.
