S I R,

I BEG to report to you that at Four o'Clock this
Evening a Luggger was seen from the Malthhead
bearing S. E. and a Brig in Chace of her E. N. E.
(which proved to be His Majesty's Sloop Actzon.
His Majesty's Sloop Orestes was in the N. W. and
joined in the Pursuit,) at Forty Minutes past Seven
