faid Prohibition should be continued for some Time longer, His Majefty doth therefore, by and with the Advice of His Privy Council, hereby order, require, prohibit, and command, that no Perfon or Perfons whatloever, (except the Master-General of the Ordnance for His Majefty's Service,) do at any Time, during the Space of Six Months, to commence from the faid Sixth Day of June next, prefume to transport into any Parts out of this Kingdom, or carry Coaftwife, any Gunpowder or Salt-Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Aminunition, or ship or lade any Gunpowder or Salt-Petre, or any Sort of Arms or Ammunition, on board any Ship or Veffel, in order to transporting the same into any Parts beyond the Seas, or carrying the fame Coaftwife, without Leave or Permiffion in that Behalf first obtained from His Majefty or His Privy Council, upon Pain of incurring and fuffering the respective Forfeitures and Pering and luttering the respective Fortenures and re-nalties inflicted by an Act, paffed in the Twenty-ninth Year of His late Majefty's Reign, initialed "An "Act to empower His Majefty to prohibit the "Exportation of Salt-Petre, and to enforce the "Law for empowering His Majefty to prohibit "the Exportation of Gunpowder, or any Sort of "Arms or Ammunition: and allo to empower "Arms or Ammunition; and also to empower ". His Majelty to reitrain the carrying Coaftwife of " Salt-Petre, Gunpowder, or any Sort of Arms or "Ammunition:"-And the Right Honorable the Lords Commissioners of His Majelty's Treasury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, the Master-General and the reft of the principal Officers of the Ordnance, and His Majelty's Secretary at War, are to give the neceffary Directions herein, as to them may refpec-W.
