any of the British Plantations in the West Indies, or to any of His Majefty's Settlements in South America; provided the Merchant Exporter shall firft verify, upon Oath, that the Articles fo exported are intended for the Use of a particular Plantation or Settlement, to be named in the Entry Outwards, and not for Sale; and that the faid Plantation or Settlement has not before been furnished with any Supply of the faid Articles during the fame Seafon ; and provided also that the Exportation of the faid Articles shall, in no Cafe, exceed the Value of Fifty Pounds Sterling for any given Plantation or Settle-ment, whether by one or more Shipments within the fame Seafon: And the Right Honourable the Lords Commiffioners of His Majelly's Treatury, the Commissioners for executing the Office of Lord High Admiral of Great Britain, and the Lord Warden of the Cinque Ports, are to give the neceffary Directions herein as to them may refpec-tively appertain.
