Upon their Return from Sca, until they can be appointed Officers in confequence of Vacancies having occurred, they shall be employed as Overfeers of Ships building, in affifting the Mafter Shipwright in the different Yards, and their Affiftants or Foremen; in the Mould Loft, under the Timber Mafter, or in any other Situation in which the Mafter Shipwright may have Occasion to employ them, with the Approbation of the Commissioner; during that Interval they shall have 1501. per Annum, and if such Vacancies should not happen for Three Years after their Return, they shall then have 1801. per Annum until they be provided for.

In order that the Services of young Men, whole Education has been obtained at a confiderable Expence to Government, may not be loft on the Expiration of their Apprenticefhip, they fhall each of them, previoufly to their Entry in the Yard, be required to find two Sureties, to enter into Bond to the Amount of 5001. and in the Event of an Apprentice being difcharged for Mifconduct, the Amount of the Bond, or fo much of it as may indemnify Government for the Expence incurred in his Education, fhall be forfeited.

The Object of this Inflitution is to improve the Qualifications of the Shipwrights in the Dock-Yards, and thereby to enfure a Succeffion of Artificers, from among whom Officers of the Defcription of Mafter Meafarers, Foremen, Ec. will be felected, and from those the Appointments of the fuperior Officers in His Maiefty's Dock-Yards, and Surveyors of the Navy, will ultimately be made.

The Day of Examination is fixed for the First Wednefday in November next (7th November 1810). A certain Number of Apprentices now in the Dock-Yards are to be excised from manual Labour, to prepare themfelves for the Examination; and this public Notice of the Qualifications expected from those who intend to become Candidates, and of the Day on which fuch Candidates will be examined, is given, in order that the Number to be entered in the Superior Class of Apprentices (which in the First Year is to be limited to Twelve) may be felected from those beft qualified, whether belonging to the Dock Yard or not.
