IIIS MAJESTY having been graciously pleased to command that, in Commemoration of the brilliant Victories obtained by Divisions of His Army over the Enemy in the Battles of Roleia, Vimiera, also in the several Instances where the Cavalry had an Opportunity of diftinguishing themselves against the Enemy in Spain, and in the Battles of Corunna and Talavera de la Reyna, the under-mentioned Officers of the Army, present on those Occasions, should enjoy the Privilege of bearing a Medal; and His Majesty having approved of the Medal which has been struck, is pleased to command that it should be worn by the General Officers, suspended by a Ribbon of the Colour of the Sash, with a blue Edge, round the Neck; and by the Commanding Officers of Corps, (not being of Rank inferior to Lieutenant-Colonel,) and the Chiefs of Military Departments, attached by a Ribbon of the same Colour to the Button Hole of their Uniform.

His Majesty has also been pleased to command, that the Medals which would have been conferred upon the Officers who have failen at or died since the above-named Actions, shall, as a Token of Respect for their Memories, he deposited with their respective Families.
