## BY THE LORDS COMMISSIONERS OF HIS MAJESTY'S TREASURY.

WHEREAS by an Act paffed in the Forty-VV fecond Year of His prefent Majelty's Reign, intituled "An Act to alter and amend in Act passed in the Thirty-ninth Year of His prefent Majesty's Reign, intituled, An Act for rendering more commodious, and for better regulating the Port of London, fo far as the fame relates to the Concerns of the Welt India Dock Company thereby eltablished; and for extending to other Objects the Compensations directed to be made by the faid Act;" it is amongst other. Things enacted as follows :

And be it further enacted, that when any one or more of the faid Docks by the faid recited Act and this Act authorized to be made, and built by the faid Directors, with the Bafin or Balins, Quays, Wharfs, Warehoules, and other Works belonging or to belong thereto, shall be fo far compleated that in the Judgement of the Lord High Treasurer, or any Three or more of the Lords Committioners, of His Majefty's Treatury for the Time being, the fame shall be fit for the Reception of Ships and Goods respectively; it shall be lawful for the faid Lord High Treature, or any Three or more of the Lord High Treasurer, or any Three or more of the Lords Commiffioners of His Majefty's Treafury for the Time being, and he and they are hereby respec-tively authorized and empowered by Writing under his or their Hand or Hands, to certify and make known the fame; which Certificate shall be publifhed Three Times at the least in the London Gazette, and in Two of more Morning Papers
