

Lanvihangel Tram Road.

Notice is hereby given, that Application is now making to Parliament for Power to deviate near both Extremities of and from the Line of the intended Rail Road to be made from the Brecknock and Abergavenny Canal, in the Parish of Lanwenarth, to or near to the Village of Lanvihangel Crucorney, both in the County of Monmouth, and for which a Bill is now pending in Parliament, and that the Deviation, at the Commencement of such Rail Road, will begin near the Coal Wharf in the said Parish of Lanwenarth, and pass above Penyr Worlod, below Lanfoyst House and Church, and near to the Maerdy, in the Parish of Lanfoyst, and cross the River Usk at the Distance of a few Yards above Abergavenny Bridge, and will join the intended Road in or near to a Field of Mills Parry's, in the Parish of Lantillio Pertholey, in the Occupation of William Price; and that the Deviation, at the extreme End thereof, will begin near Blaengavenny, in or near a Field of Hugh Powell's, Esq; in the Parish of Lanvihangel-Crucorney, in the Occupation of Matthew Gwabkin, and pass through and along the Land of the said Hugh Powell, on the West Side of Lanvihangel Crucorney Church, and join the said Rail Road near the Village, and within the said Parish of Lanvihangel Crucorney, which said Deviations will pass through the several Parishes of Lanwenarth, Lanfoyst, Abergavenny, Lantillio Pertholey, and Lanvihangel Crucorney, in the County of Monmouth.—Penyr Worlod, April 6, 1811.
