All Persons intending to bid for any of the said Duties, are to deliver in their Proposals, addressed to the Commissioners at the Stamp-Office, Somerset-Place, at least Three Days previous to the said 27th Day of November next, signed with their Names, stating the Places of their Abode, and specifying the District or Districts for which they intend to bid, otherwise their Proposals cannot be proceeded upon.

And no Persons licensed to let Horses for the Purpose of travelling Post; nor any one for their Use, can be admitted to contract for any of the said Duties.
