By virtue of the authority in me vested, and in conformity with an ordinance of the 23d May, and an edict of the 12th August 1800, I do hereby make known, that, in compliance with a petition delivered in, I have permitted and granted that the Honourable Dealing Court for the jurisdiction of Christiansted, in this island, as administering the Bankrupt estate of Mr. Hans Brink, may summon by proclama sub pœna præclusi et perpetui silentii, all the known or unknown Creditors in the said Mr. Hans Brink's Bankrupt Estate, residing in European or American territories, to come forward with their demands, and to enter and prove their claims, in person or by their attorneys, before the said Dealing Court, previous to the expiration of the period herein-after limited; that is to say, within one year and six weeks

from the period when this proclama shall have been recorded in the Upper Courts of the islands of St. Croix, St. Thomas, and St. John, and published three times consecutively in the London Gazette; and all such known or unknown Creditors as reside in any of the West India islands or colonies, shall come forward with their demands, and enter and prove their claims, in person or by their attorneys, before the said Dealing Court, within three months from the date of this proclama being recorded in the Superior and Inferior Courts of the islands of St. Croix, St. Thomas, and St. John, and notice thereof being published in the St. Croix Gazette three times consecutively.
