IT is this day ordered by His Royal Highness the Prince Regent, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, and by and with the advice of His Majesty's Privy Council, that His Grace the Lord Archbishop of Canterbury do prepare the Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving to Almighty God, for the abundant Harvest; to be read immediately after the General Thanksgiving, on Sunday the tenth day of October next, and to be continued until Sunday the seventeenth day of the same month inclusive: and it is hereby ordered, that His Majesty's Printer do forthwith print a competent number of the said Form of Prayer and Thanksgiving, that the same may be forthwith sent round and read as above directed, in the several Churches and Chapels throughout those parts of the United Kingdom called England and Ireland.

IT is this day ordered, by His Royal Highness the Prince Regent in Council, in the name and on the behalf of His Majesty, that every Minister or Preacher, as well of the established Church in

that part of Great Britain called Scotland, as those of the Episcopal Communion, protected and allowed by an Act passed in the tenth year of Her late Majesty Queen Anne, cap. 7. intituled, "An Act to prevent the disturbing those of the Episcopal Communion, in that part of Great Britain called Scotland, in the exercise of their religious worship, and in the use of the Liturgy of the Church of England," and for repealing an Act passed in the Parliament of Scotland, intituled "An Act against irregular Baptisms and Marriages," do at some time during the exercise of the divine service, in such respective Church, congregation or assembly, on Sunday the tenth, and until Sunday the seventeenth of October next inclusive, or from the first Sunday until the second Sunday after notice hereof shall have been received, put up Prayers, and Thanksgivings to Almighty God for the abundant Harvest.
