In pursuance therefore of an Act of the 53d Geo. 3. cap. 35, intituled "An Act to alter and amend several Acts passed in His present Majesty's reign, relating to the redemption of the National Debt, and for making further provision in respect thereof," we do hereby declare, that the interest or yearly dividend on the Capital Stock purchased by or transferred to us, up to the 21st day of December 1813 as aforesaid, exceeds the annual charge in perpetual redeemable annuities of the said Public Funded Debt, existing at the 5th of January 1786, by the sum of £1250 13 9¼.
