Head and Folly-Bridge; which tolls have been let
for the last year, at a rent of 620l. clear of all
expences to the commission; and whoever happens
to be the best bidder must, at the time of letting,
pay down a deposit of 10l. per cent. of the annual
sum agreed upon, and at the time of executing the
lease, make up that deposit one quarter's rent,
which is always to be paid in advance, and give
