

CONTRACT FOR TAR.

Navy-Office, April 25, 1817.

THE Principal Officers and Commissioners of His Majesty's Navy do hereby give notice, that on Wednesday the 7th of May next, at one o'clock, they will be ready to treat with such persons as may be willing to contract for supplying His Majesty's several Yards with

Stockholm or Archangel Tar.

A distribution of the tar, and a form of the tender, may be seen at this Office.

No tender will be received after one o'clock on the day of treaty, nor any noticed, unless the party, or an agent for him, attends.

Every tender must be accompanied by a letter addressed to the Navy Board, and signed by two responsible persons, engaging to become bound with the person tendering, in the sum of £50 per 100 barrels of tar, for the due performance of the contract.

Proposals must be made separately for each county, island, or place, except for the counties comprising North and South Wales, all of which must be included in one tender, as also must the several counties in North Britain; and the proposal for the supply of forage in Guernsey, must include Alderney;
