" ported into Great Britain from any port or place " within the limits of the charter granted to the "United Company of Merchants of England " trading to the East Indies, and to grant other " duties in lieu thereof, and to establish further regulations for the better security of the revenue on goods so imported, and to alter the periods of of making up and presenting certain accounts of the said Company to Parliament; to con-" tinue in force until the tenth day of April one " thousand eight hundred and nineteen:" And the Right Honourable the Lords Commissioners of His Majesty's Treasury are to give the necessary Chetwynd. directions herein accordingly.
