

**P**ursuant to a Decree of the High Court of Chancery, made in a Cause *Hutchinson* against *Dickinson*, the Creditors of *David Gordon Hutchinson*, late of *Liverpool*, in the County of *Lancaster*, *Lincolns*, deceased (who died on or about the 16th day of *May* 1819), are, on or before the 24th day of *April* 1822, to come in and prove their debts before *William Courtenay*, Esq. one of the Masters of the said Court, at his Chambers, in *Southampton Buildings*, *Chancery-Lane*, *London*, or in default thereof they will be peremptorily excluded the benefit of the said Decree.
