HEREAS His Majesty was pleased, by His Order in Council, bearing date the fifteenth November last, to order, require, prohibit, and command, that no person or persons whatsoever (except the Master-General of the Ordnance for His Majesty's service) should, at any time during the space of six months (to commence from the thirtieth day of November then instant), presume to transport any gun-powder or salt-petre. or any sort of arms or ammunition, to any port or place within the dominions of the King of Spain, or to any port or place on the Coast of Africa (except to any ports or places within the Streights of Gibraltar), or in the West Indies, or on any part of the Continent of America (except to a port or place, or ports or places in His Majesty's territories or possessions on the Continent of North America, or in the territories of the United States of America), or ship or lade any gun-powder or salt-petre, or any sort of arms or ammunition, on board any ship or vessel, in order to transporting the same into any such ports or places within the dominions of the King of Spain, or into any such port or place on the Coast of Africa (except as above excepted), or in the West Indies, or on the Continent of America (except as above ex-
