

Pursuant to a Decree of the High Court of Chancery, made in a Cause Burchett against Woolvord, the Creditors of George Cuming, late of Northbrooke, in the Parish of Godalming, in the County of Surrey, Esq. deceased (who died on or about the 25th day of June 1814), are forthwith to come in and prove their debts before Francis Cross, Esq. one of the Masters of the said Court, at his Chambers, in Southampton-Buildings, Chancery-Lane, London, or in default thereof they will be excluded the benefit of the said Decree.
