

*Foreign-Office, Downing-Street, November 17, 1831.*

Whereas on the 19th July 1830, a Convention, between His Britannic Majesty and the Government of the United Provinces of Rio de la Plata, was concluded and signed at Buenos Ayres, for the purpose of establishing a Commission to consider and decide upon all cases that shall be brought before it, properly authenticated, of the capture and seizure of British vessels, or detention of property belonging to the subjects of His Britannic Majesty, during the continuance of the war between that Republic and the Emperor of Brazil; the Commissioners appointed in pursuance of the said Convention hereby give notice that, under the power vested in them, they are ready to receive, hear, and determine, at their Office, in the Foreign-Office, Downing-street, all claims of the nature aforesaid; and all persons whom it may concern are hereby desired to observe the stipulation contained in the fourth article of the said Convention, whereby no claim will be admitted, which is not submitted to the Commission within six months after the present notice.
