*St. James's-Palace, July 3, 1833.*

**T**HIS day the Count de Ludolf, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the King of the Kingdom of the Two Sicilies; and the Chevalier Vial, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from His Catholic Majesty, had audiences respectively of His Majesty to deliver letters from their Sovereigns:

To which they were introduced by Lord Viscount Palmerston, His Majesty's Principal Secretary of State for Foreign Affairs, and conducted by Sir Robert Chester, Knt. Master of the Ceremonies.
