The King has been pleased to give and grant unto Alexander Houstoun, Clerk, of Baads, in the shire of Edinburgh, and of Hartley Maudit, in the county of Southampton, late Rector of Hartley Maudit aforesaid, His royal licence and authority that he and his issue may (in compliance with a direction contained in a deed of disposition and entail executed by his grandfather, Alexander Douglas, of Baads aforesaid, Esq. deceased) henceforth use and bear the surname and designation of Douglas of Baads, in addition to and after that of Houstoun, tenant-Colonel, by purchase, vice Sir Edward and also bear the arms of Douglas of Baads; Miles, who retires.
