

St. James's-Palace, November 20, 1834.

This day had audiences of His Majesty:

The Count D'Aglie, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the King of Sardinia, to deliver credentials from the Duke of Lucca, accrediting him provisionally as His Royal Highness's Minister at this Court.

And the Chevalier de Moraes Sarmiento, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the Queen of Portugal and the Algarves, to deliver letters from his Sovereign:

To which audiences they were respectively introduced by the Duke of Wellington, one of His Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, and conducted by the Master of the Ceremonies.

Whitehall, November 17, 1834.

The King has been pleased to direct letters patent to be passed under the Great Seal, granting the dignity of a Baronet of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, unto Felix Booth, of Roydon-lodge, in the county of Essex, Esq. and to the heirs male of his body lawfully begotten.
