suit in equity, for the recovery, defence, or protection of any part of the said Insolvent's estate, effects, or expectancies; and for authorising the Assignee to submit same, if necessary, to arbitration, or otherwise to adjust any outstanding claims; and particularly to confer as to the claims of the Insolvent under a suit Yates versus Yates, now pending in equity, and to authorise the Assignee how to act in reference thereto; and generally in reference to the affairs of the estate.
