The King has been pleased to grant unto the Spanish Brigadier-General John Kinloch His royal licence and permission that he may accept and wear the insignia of the Order of Saint Ferdinand, of the first class, which the Queen Regent of Spain has been pleased to confer upon him, in testimony of her approbation of his services, especially at the battle of Arlaban, on the 16th and 17th of January 1836, and that he may enjoy all the rights and privileges thereunto annexed; provided, nevertheless, that His Majesty's said licence and permission doth not authorise, the assumption of any stile, appellation, rank, precedence, or privilege appertaining unto a Knight Bachelor of these realms:

And also to command, that the said concession and declaration, together with the relative documents, be recorded in His Majesty's College of Arms.
