Buckingham-Palace, January 24, 1838.

HIS day had audience of Her Majesty:—Baron Bülow, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the King of Prussia, upon his return to this Court after a leave of absence; Monsieur Tricoupi, Envoy Extraordinary and Minister Plenipotentiary from the King of Greece, to deliver his letter of recall; and Monsieur Soutzo, in the same character from the King of Greece, to deliver his credentials:
