May your senators enact wise and salutary laws for the suppression of vice, and the maintenance of religion; that when your spirit shall be called hence, the sincere regrets of a faithful people shall hallow your tomb, and the tear of sorrow trace down the cheek of woe the faithful tribute of departed worth.

Long be your brow free from the furrows of a care-worn countenance, the reins of government rest lightly in your hand, and the warmth of attachment to your country be responded to by the grateful homage of loving and obedient subjects.
