The Queen, taking into Her royal consideration that, upon the decease of George-William Earl of Coventry, the title and dignity of Earl of Coventry devolved upon his grandson and heir, George-William now Earl of Coventry (a minor), as only son and heir of George-William Coventry, Esq. (commonly called Viscount Deerhurst), who was, whilst living, the eldest son and heir of the said George-William late Earl of Coventry, and that, according to the ordinary rules of honour, the sister of the said George-William now Earl of Coventry cannot enjoy that place and precedence which would have been due to her, in case her said late father had survived the said George-William Earl of Coventry, and thereby succeeded to the title and dignity of Earl of Coventry, Her Majesty has been pleased to ordain and declare, that Maria-Emma-Katherine Coventry (a minor), the only sister of the said George-William now Earl of Coventry, shall henceforth have, hold, and enjoy the same title, place, pre-eminence, and precedence as if her said late father had succeeded to the said title and dignity of Earl of Coventry :

And Her Majesty has been further pleased to command, that the said royal order and declaration be registered in Her Majesty's College of Arms.
