

CONTRACT FOR BOOTS FOR THE ROYAL
MARINES.

Department of the Comptroller for Vic-
tualling and Transport Services, So-
merset-Place, October 24, 1845.

THE Commissioners for executing the office of
Lord High Admiral of the United Kingdom
of Great Britain and Ireland do hereby give notice,
that, on Friday the 7th of November next, at one
o'clock, they will be ready to treat with such persons
as may be willing to contract for supplying and
delivering into Her Majesty's Victualling Stores
at Deptford, under a contract for twelve months
certain, and further until the expiration of three
months' warning,

All such Boots as shall, from time to time,
be demanded for the use of the Royal
Marines.

*The conditions of the contract may be seen at
the said Office, and patterns of the boots on
application at the Marine Office, New-street,
Spring-gardens.*

*No tender will be received after one o'clock on
the day of treaty, nor any noticed unless the
party attends, or an agent for him duly authorized
in writing.*

*Every tender must be addressed to the Secre-
tary of the Admiralty, and bear in the left
hand corner the words, "Tender for Boots,"
and must also be delivered at Somerset-place,
accompanied by a letter, signed by a responsible
person, engaging to become bound with the
person tendering, in the sum of £200, for the due
performance of the contract.*
