plying with water the several parishes, townships, and extra-parochial or other places of Over Darwen, Eccleshill, Lower Darwen, Livesey, Tockholes, Livesey with Tockholes, Blackburn, Witton, Pleasington, Hoghton, Leyland, Samlesbury, Cuerdale, Walton-in-le-Dale, Penwortham and Preston, all in the county of Lancaster, or some of them.
